

## Summer Naturalist Fact Sheet 2019

- Must be 18 years of age
- May 13<sup>th</sup>-August 10<sup>rd</sup> 2019
- Assists in the training of Hidden Meadows Camp Counselors
- Must work a shift at the Americana Festival on July 4
- Three (un-paid) days off may be requested. Any additional requested time off will be reviewed. Requests should be made prior to May 31. **All requested days off must be approved.**

### Summer Naturalist:

The Summer Naturalists will work as a team with the Naturalist and Program Assistant to carry out all planned nature education programming in the Park District. Summer Naturalists will be in charge of planning and carrying out 4 Adventure Camps, 1 Family Nature Camp, and additional family programming. They will also provide supplemental nature programs to Hidden Meadows Day Camp, Summer Recreation Program, and Special Events. They must be willing to work a varied schedule, which includes several evenings and weekends.

40 hours/week with some overtime  
Typically 8 am-4:30 pm Monday-Friday  
Evenings and Weekends  
4 or more Overnights
