The Gold Medal Awards program honors communities in the U.S. demonstrating excellence in parks and recreation through longrange planning, resource management, volunteerism, environmental stewardship, program development, professional development and agency recognition. The award is administered by the American Academy for Park and Recreation Management (AAPRA) in partnership with the National

Recreation and Park Association (NRPA) and sponsor Musco Lighting.

Becky Benná, a member of AAPRA, attended the park board meeting virtually to present the award. Benná is the Executive Director of Five Rivers MetroParks.
